

MID-TECH INDUSTRIAL

- Flexible lab / manufacturing / industrial
- Single storey (7m + ceiling height) with opportunity for additional mezzanine floors
- Supported by R&D / office facilities
- Suitable for pilot plant and scale-up facilities
- Spaces from 2,000 to 50,000 sq ft






READY FOR BUSINESS




